- Colorado's thriving recreation economy
- Impact of drought, floods and fire
- Gold King Mine Spill
- Diverse recreational interests

Missionary Ridge Fire



- 2002 fire consumed 73,000 acres including 56 homes
- Skies were darkened and thick with smoke
- Tourism and outdoor recreation declined

Recreational In-channel Diversion



- 2007 water rights for boating
- Economic impacts of whitewater recreation is over \$19 million annually
- In-stream improvements assist with boating conditions during drought

Gold King Mine Spill



- 2015 event released 3 million gallons of toxic wastewater into Animas River watershed
- River closed to recreation in Durango
- Superfund site


Resilient Recreationalists

- Thrill seeking instead of fear


Gold Medal Waters

- Despite environmental challenges




Riparian Habitat
