**RESOLUTION 2020-04 TO SET MILL LEVIES**

**A RESOLUTION LEVYING PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2020 TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE SOUTHWESTERN WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT, COLORADO, FOR THE 2021 BUDGET YEAR.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors of Southwestern Water Conservation District, has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on December 9, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating purposes from property tax revenue is \$1,588,850; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2020 valuation for assessment for the Southwestern Water Conservation District as certified by the County Assessors is \$3,903,809,235.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF SOUTHWESTERN WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT, COLORADO.**

Section 1. That for the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses of the Southwestern Water Conservation District during the 2021 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of .407 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the Counties for the year 2020.

Section 2. That Jenny Russell, Secretary-Treasurer, is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of La Plata, Archuleta, Dolores, Hinsdale, Mineral, Montezuma, Montrose, San Juan and San Miguel Counties, Colorado, the mill levy for the Southwestern Water Conservation District as hereinabove determined and set, but as recalculated as needed upon receipt of the final (December) certification of valuation from the county assessors in order to comply with any applicable revenue and other budgetary limits.
